Who are the L2LPs designed for?

As stated in the Junior Cycle for Framework pg. 23, Level 2 Learning Programmes (L2LPs) are designed for a small number of students with particular special educational needs. L2LPs are designed to provide curricular access to students with learning disabilities in the low mild to high moderate range of abilities. The special needs of these students are such as to prevent them from accessing some or all of the subjects and short courses on offer at junior cycle that are broadly aligned with Level 3 of the NFQ.

Most students of Junior Cycle age in these categories are enrolled in special schools. Others are in special classes in mainstream post-primary schools, and some are in mixed-ability classes in these schools. In a typical post-primary school, they may amount to a very small number of students. It is envisaged that as far as possible the students under consideration here who are in mainstream settings will undertake their L2LPs in mainstream classes. Of course, there may be occasions when small group or one-to-one teaching is more appropriate to support the students' learning. It should be noted that most students with higher mild general learning disabilities should be able to access most, if not all, subjects and short courses through differentiated teaching, learning and assessment. Varied use of resource allocation such as teamteaching, small group and individual withdrawal, may also facilitate ease of access to subjects and short courses.
