



Microsoft Forms: Create Adaptive Assessments Using Branching

The branching option in Forms allows teachers to create formative assessments that provide different pathways based on student responses. Branching allows the quiz creator to pre-emptively adapt which question or section a respondent is presented with depending on their previous response.

Try it out...

To explore branching, select the hyperlink below to take a quiz created by Microsoft which includes branching. *Please note, your personal data is not being recorded by completing this quiz.*

- 1. Try getting the first question correct.
- 2. Then input an incorrect response for the second question. You will see that the creator of this quiz included reteach moments and options for students to try certain questions again.
- 3. Continue through the quiz inputting some incorrect/correct responses to experience different pathways learners may take depending on their understanding.
